Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government of Rajasthan has sent any proposal to the Union Government to set up Multi Disciplinary Research Units (MDRU) in the Medical Colleges of Raj – MES;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to approve the project of MDRU in the medical colleges at Bharatpur, Bhilwara, Churu, Pali and Dungarpur of Raj MES and release funds in this regard; and
- (c) if so, the time by which the said project is likely to be approved and the funds are likely to be released and if not, the reasons therefor?

- 7) Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur
- 8) Government Medical College, Dungarpur
- (b) and (c): The proposals of Government of Rajasthan for setting up Multi Disciplinary Research Units in Government Medical Colleges at Bharatpur, Bhilwara, Churu and Pali were also received and the respective Colleges advised to resubmit the proposals in accordance with the Guidelines for the Central Sector Scheme of setting up Multi Disciplinary Research Units.
