(a) & (b) Yes Sir, Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways has formulated scheme to engage talented, forward-thinking and dynamic young professionals in various wings of the Ministry. This scheme focuses on active on-the-ground learning for young professionals. The professionals will have the opportunity to learn about the functioning of the Government as well as developmental policy concerns.

(c) & (d) The scheme will foster active involvement of young people in decisionmaking. Initially, more than 25 young professionals will be hired under this scheme through Web-Portal of the Ministry and National Career Service Portal of Ministry of Labour and Employment.
