2118: MS CHANDRANI MURMU:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Government and private nursing colleges in the country, State/UT-wise including Odisha; and
- (b) the necessary steps taken by the Government to increase the number of nursing staff in the country?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (Dr. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

- (a) There are 2241 Colleges of Nursing (CoN) in the country including 176 Government Colleges. State/UT-wise Government and private Colleges of Nursing in the country, including Odisha is at **Annexure.**
- (b) Steps taken by the Government to increase nursing manpower in the country are as follows:
 - i. The requirement of land for School/College of Nursing and Hostel relaxed.
- ii. Relaxation in the norms of having a 100 bedded parent hospital for hilly and tribal areas.
- iii. The student teacher ratio for M.Sc.(N) programme relaxed from 1:5 to 1:10.
- iv. Student patient ratio for Nursing Institutions relaxed from 1:5 to 1:3.
- v. Maximum number of 100 seats for Nursing College to be given to parent hospitals with 300 beds without insisting for a Medical College.
- vi. Distance from school/college to hospital relaxed from 15 Km to 30 Km. For hilly and tribal areas the maximum distance is 50 Km.
- vii. Eligibility criteria to admission for Diploma and Degree relaxed.
- viii. Relaxation in norms for opening M.Sc. (N) programme by allowing Super Speciality Hospital to start M.Sc. (N) without having under graduate programme.
- ix. Under the Central Sector Scheme "Development of Nursing Services" School of Nursing(SoN) are given Grants-in-aid to upgrade them into College of Nursing(CoN).
