INFRASTRUCTURAL DEVELOPMENT UNDER PM CARES FUND

2131. DR. M.P. ABDUSSAMAD SAMADANI:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to develop hospitals and other infrastructure facilities in the health sector under the National Health Mission (NHM) Program and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has implemented any scheme in the health sector under the PM CARES fund and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of infrastructural development activities implemented in Kerala?

(a) to (c): Ministry of Health and Family Welfare provides technical and financial support to the States/UTs to strengthen the public healthcare delivery at public healthcare facilities. Support under National Health Mission (NHM) is provided to States/ UTs to supplement the efforts of the State/UT governments, for setting up of new facilities as per norms and upgradation of existing facilities for bridging the infrastructure and human resource gaps, based on the requirements posted by them in their Programme Implementation Plans (PIPs) and within their overall resource envelope.

Rural Health Statistics (RHS) is an annual publication, based on Health care administrative data reported by States/UTs. As per RHS 2020-21, the State/UT-wise details of Sub-centres, PHCs, CHCs functioning in rural & urban areas is at **Annexure-I**. Further, as per RHS 2020-21, the State/UT-wise details of Sub Divisional Hospital, District Hospital & Medical Colleges functioning is at **Annexure-II**.

No scheme is implemented under NHM by Government of India with the support of PM CARES Fund. However, with the support of PM-CARES fund 1225 PSA plants have been established at public health facilities in the country, including 26 PSA Plants in Kerala State.

As per information received from Govt. of Kerala, support is provided under NHM for various infrastructural development activities (5 District Hospital, 1 Sub-District Hospital, 5 Community Health Centres, 34 Primary Health Centres, 20 Sub-Centre) for last three years (Financial Year 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22).
