DETAILS OF AYUSH HOSPITAL/DISPENSARIES

Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Ayush Colleges/Institutes of Medical Sciences across the country, State/UT wise;
- (b) the State where Ayush colleges/institutes are proposed to be opened;
- (c) the funds sanctioned and allocated for the said institutions; and
- (d) the time by which these institutes/colleges are likely to be made functional?

ANSWER MINISTRY OF AYUSH (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

- (a) The details of Ayush Colleges/ Institutes of Medical Sciences across the country, State/UT wise, for academic year 2021-22 is attached as **Annexure-I.**
- (b) The Satellite Centers of the existing National Institutes namely National Institutes of Ayurveda (NIA), Jaipur is being established at Panchkula, Haryana and Satellite Center of the existing All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA), New Delhi is being established at Goa.

Similarly, Satellite Center of the existing National Institute of Unani Medicine, Bangalore has been established at Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh and Satellite Center of the existing National Institute of Homeopathy, Kolkata, has been established at Narela, New Delhi.

Further, total 154 proposals have been received in NCISM (National Commission for Indian system of Medicine) and NCH (National Commission for Homeopathy) regarding establishment of new Ayush Medical Colleges, for the Academic Year 2022-23. The State wise details of received proposals are placed at **Annexure-II.** The Letter of Permission is to be issued subject to their fulfilling the requirement under relevant Acts and Regulations.

(c) and (d) Public Health being a State subject, setting up of Ayush colleges/institutes comes under the purview of respective State/UT Governments. However, under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the National Ayush Mission (NAM), there is provision for establishment of new AYUSH colleges in the States where availability of AYUSH teaching institutions is inadequate in Government Sector. Further, under NAM, as per the proposal received from the State/ UT Governments through their State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs), 9 units have been approved for establishment of new colleges in States/UTs. The funds sanctioned/allocated for Ayush colleges/institutes from the year 2014-15 to 2020-21 are furnished at Annexure-III. Further, the fund sanctioned to Satellite Institutions of existing National Institutions is annexed as Annexure-IV.
