- (c) the steps being taken to develop indigenous combat jet engines in the country?

(a) to (c): Indigenous capability exists with DRDO and Indian industries for design, development and manufacturing of 80kN combat jet engine.

Collaboration with a foreign engine house is being explored for co-development and co-production of the higher class thrust engines for AMCA.

The cost including technology transfer for manufacturing the jet engine can be known after further progress.
