- (a) whether the Government has undertaken extensive stakeholder consultation for preparation of a draft Policy on "Petroleum, Chemicals and Petrochemicals Investment Regions" in India (PCPIR Policy) 2020-2035 and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Viable Gap Funding (VGF) for development of PCPIR at Paradeep could be revised and increased to Rs. 3000 crore as against the limit of Rs. 1000 crore sanctioned previously;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the assistance/funding under PCPIR policy could be in the form of a grant rather than a VGF, taking into consideration the current market sentiments for PPP; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?
