“SPREAD OF MALAIRA AND ENCEPHALITIS”

2171: SHRI RAMSHIROMANI VERMA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether cases of fatal disease like Malaria, Encephalitis have been reported in different parts of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise especially in Uttar Pradesh;
- (c) whether the Government is taking efforts to take any concrete steps to control these diseases in a time bound manner; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) **Malaria** cases are reported from 35 States/UTs and **Japanese Encephalitis (JE)** cases are reported from 24 States/UTs of the country, including Uttar Pradesh. The State/ UT wise Malaria and JE cases in 2021 are placed at **Annexure-1**.

(c) & (d) The Government has launched the National Framework for Malaria Elimination (NFME), 2016-2030 to eliminate malaria from India by 2030.

For prevention, control and elimination of Vector Borne Diseases (including Malaria and Japanese Encephalitis) budgetary support is provided to States/UTs under the overarching umbrella of National Health Mission.

National Center for Vector Borne Diseases Control (NCVBDC) provides technical support to States/UTs for programme implementation in terms of integrated vector management, early diagnosis & treatment, capacity building, epidemic preparedness, monitoring and evaluation etc.

For prevention and control of JE, programme specific interventions are establishment of pediatric ICU, strengthening of Physical Medicine Rehabilitation (PMR) units, establishment of Sentinel surveillance hospitals (SSHs) for augmenting the diagnostic services etc. are also taken.
