Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Vaccine Preventable Diseases (VPDs) covered at present under the Universal Immunization Programme across the country;
- (b) the total number of districts which have achieved 90 percent immunization coverage so far; and
- (c) the time by which the country is likely to achieve its goal of Universal Immunization of children?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) 12 Vaccine Preventable diseases are covered, under the Universal Immunization programme (UIP), of which 11 (eleven) are covered Nationally and 1(one) is covered subnationally.

(b)As per Data reported by States/UTs in Health Management Information System portal (HMIS-2021-2022), a total of 315 districts have achieved 90 percent full Immunization coverage

(c) Universal Immunization Programme (UIP) is a dynamic program across the country and all States/UTs are covered under it. A new birth cohort is added every year and they are included to be covered under the Universal Immunization Programme.
