**OSCs IN JHARKHAND**

2211. SHRI SANJAY SETH:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of ongoing One Stop Centers (OSCs) run by the Ministry in Jharkhand;
- (b) whether the said OSCs are being operated under the supervision of the State Government or by any private agencies, if so, the details in respect of Ranchi district
- (c) the number of beneficiaries benefited through the OSCs so far in the State, district-wise; and
- (d) the amount released for the operation of OSCs to the Jharkhand including Ranchi district during the last one years, district-wise?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d) The One Stop Centre (OSC) scheme has been implemented with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015 to provide integrated support and assistance to women affected by violence and in distress. Under the newly launched Mission Shakti, which is an umbrella scheme for the safety, security and empowerment of women for implementation during the 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission Period 2021-22 to 2025-26, OSC has been included as a component of 'Sambal' sub-scheme. The OSCs function under the overall supervision and management of State Governments/ District Authorities. However, the Ministry provides 100% grant-in-aid to Districts for recurring and non-recurring expenditure as well as for construction of OSCs (in respect of those which have been approved for construction).

All the 24 OSCs approved for 24 Districts of Jharkhand are functional, including one in Ranchi. These centres have assisted over 2000 women in the State till June 2022. The number of women assisted through the OSCs and the amount released for the operation of OSCs to the State of Jharkhand, including Ranchi district, during the last one year, district-wise is at Annexure.
