# LOK SABHA UN STARRED QUESTION NO. 2231 TO BE ANSWERED ON 29.07.2022

#### **FACILITIES AT ANGANWADI CENTRES IN JHARKHAND**

#### 2231. SHRI CHANDRA PRAKASH CHOUDHARY:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Anganwadi centres opened in the State of Jharkhand during the last four years;
- (b) whether all Anganwadi centres have access to clean drinking water and sanitation facilities and if not, the number of such centres in the State of Jharkhand;
- (c) whether all the vacancies across Anganwadis in the State of Jharkhand have been filled, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor district-wise; and
- (d) the corrective measures being taken by the Government in this regard?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) As informed by the State Government of Jharkhand, no new Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) have been opened during the last four years. However, all the 38,432 sanctioned AWCs are operational in the State of Jharkhand.
- (b) As informed by the State of Jharkhand, 22,438 AWCs have clean drinking water facilities and 15,994 AWCs do not have clean drinking water facilities. Further 18,397 AWCs have sanitation facilities and 20,035 AWCs do not have sanitation facilities.
- (c) & (d) As informed by the State of Jharkhand, there are 771 vacant posts of Anganwadi Workers (AWWs) and 827 vacant posts of Anganwadi Helpers (AWHs). District-wise number of sanctioned and vacant posts of AWWs and AWHs is annexed. Government of India has been taking up various issues, including filling up of vacant positions on priority basis for robust implementation of the scheme with State Governments/UT Administrations including through zonal conferences across the country. In addition, an advisory was issued to all States/UTs to authorize the District Collectors/Magistrates to recruit AWWs and AWHs at their own level.
