**EFFICACY OF COVID VACCINE**

**2249. SHRIMATI SAJDA AHMED:  
SHRI SAUMITRA KHAN:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has assessed the efficacy of the COVID vaccines administered across all age group and body weight;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of people who have been covered under the 'Har Ghar Dastak door-to-door vaccination Campaign, State/UT-wise particularly in West Bengal; and
- (d) whether the State Government of West Bengal has come forward actively with central agencies in making this campaign successful;
- (e) the details of unvaccinated people and those who have missed second dose found under Har Ghar Dastak Drive, State/UT-wise;
- (f) whether the new omicron sub-variant BA.2 and 2.38 have been reported in cluster formation, if so details thereof; and
- (g) the details of Booster dose administered so far, State/UT-wise?

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE  
(DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)**

(a) to (g): The national regulator Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO) has approved COVID-19 vaccines after due consideration of the safety and efficacy data.

As per CoWIN portal, the number of people unvaccinated against the estimated population and beneficiaries due for second dose at the beginning of Har Ghar Dastak 2.0 (1<sup>st</sup> June 2022) is at annexure-1.

From 1<sup>st</sup> June 2022 'Har Ghar Dastak 2.0' campaign has been launched for identifying and vaccinating beneficiaries due for 2<sup>nd</sup> dose and precaution dose in  $\geq 60$  years age group through door-to-door activity and vaccination of children aged 12-18 years through school based campaign. From 15<sup>th</sup> July

2022 a 75 day campaign “COVID-19 Vaccination Amrit Mahotsava” has been initiated to cover all beneficiaries above 18 years of age with free precaution doses at Government CVCs. State/UT wise details regarding the number of people who have been administered with covid vaccines (1<sup>st</sup> dose, 2<sup>nd</sup> dose and precaution dose) since 1<sup>st</sup> June 2022 to 26<sup>th</sup> July 2022 is at annexure-2.

Number of precaution dose administrated as on 26<sup>th</sup> July 2022, State/UT wise is at annexure-3.

The new Omicron sub-variants i.e., BA.2 and BA.2.38 has been reported in clustered form as per IHIP portal.
