#### RECRUITMENT DRIVE FOR SOLDIERS

#### 2250. SHRI OMPRAKASH BHUPALSINH alias PAWAN RAJENIMBALKAR:

Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of military recruitment drive organized from 2021 to June 2022;
- (b) the total number of the soldiers recruited in February, 2021 at Belgaum military recruitment drive;
- (c) whether joining letters have been sent to the soldiers recruited under the said drive and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the 2021 Belgaum Army recruitment has been cancelled due to Corona pandemic, if so, the details thereof;
- (e) if not, the time by which joining letters are likely to be sent to selected candidates; and
- (f) the measures taken by the Government to conduct recruitment for candidates who crossed age limit due to Corona pandemic?

- (a) to (e): Rallies are organized in a systematic manner to cover all districts of the country. One rally covers approximately 06 to 07 districts. Belgaum was also covered in the similar way. However, due to COVID-19, the recruitment process was put on hold. As the entire process of recruitment could not be completed, the joining letters were not issued to any candidate.
- (f): The upper age limit has been increased from existing 21 years to 23 years as one time measure for Recruiting year 2022-23.
