STATUS OF NATIONAL VIRTUAL LIBRARY OF INDIA

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- a) the current status of the National Virtual Library of India (NVLI) project;
- b) the details of funds allocated and utilised towards the NVLI project;
- the steps taken by the Ministry to increase the amount of knowledge resources available on the National Virtual Library and to promote the usage of the NVLI in various educational institutions around the country;
- d) whether the Ministry has any plan of integrating NVLI with physical libraries in the country; and
- e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- a) National Virtual Library of India has been developed and launched as Indian Culture Portal (ICP) on 10.12.2019 by the then Hon'ble Culture Minister, to showcase all forms of tangible and intangible cultural heritage of India. The URL is https://indianculture.gov.in which is available on public domain. The current status of the portal is summarized below: -
 - It has a total of about 3.04 lakh digital artefacts, with metadata. It also has more than 34.91 lakh bibliographic entries.
 - The content is presented in 18 curated categories, such as Rare Books, E-Books, Archives, Paintings, and Union Catalogues etc.
 - It also has 12 categories of created content, such as Stories, Snippets, Historical Cities, Fort, Ajanta Caves and The North- East Archive etc.
 - The portal is currently available in English and Hindi.

- The portal can be accessed through an App called Indian Culture, available on both Android phones and iPhone.
- (b) The details of funds towards the NVLI: -

(c) The Ministry ensures that all Organisations handover both bibliographical and digital resources to the National Virtual Library of India for integration on the Indian Culture Portal on a regular basis.

An Outreach team under the National Virtual Library of India has been constituted for promotion of Indian Culture Portal at various Educational Institutions. Various Presentations, Events etc. are organised on a daily basis at various Educational Institutions for promotion of Indian Culture Portal (NVLI project).
