SKILL DEVELOPMENT IN TRIBAL AREAS

2358. SHRI RAJESHBHAI CHUDASAMA: SHRIMATI JASKAUR MEENA: SHRI ARJUN LAL MEENA:

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government has proposed/proposes to have any exclusive scheme/ project for skill development in tribal areas; and

(b) whether the Government has taken any steps to establish Skill Development Centres in the country particularly in the under privileged blocks of tribal areas;

(c) whether the Government is considering to cover districts of Rajasthan under this project; if so, the details thereof, district-wise and if not, the reasons therefor;

(d) the details along with the funds allocated and utilized, State and district-wise including districts of Rajasthan;

(e) whether the Government has decided any special policy for the Tribal Community; and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SMT. RENUKA SINGH SARUTA)

(a) to (d): Under Skill India Mission, the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) has been delivering short term skills through **Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana** (PMKVY) to the youth belonging to all sections of the society including tribal community. PMKVY has the mandatory provision of utilization of funds for tribals through Scheduled Tribe Component (STC). The details of fund allocation under Tribal Sub Plan in the PMKVY Scheme in FY 2022-23 are given below:

Since 2015, an extensive Skill India network has been created viz. PMKVY 1.0, PMKVY 2.0 and PMKVY 3.0 training centres (including Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra). MSDE through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) promotes establishment of model and aspirational skill centres known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) for imparting skill training in every district throughout the country including the districts of Rajasthan. The list of PMKKs in tribal majority districts with more than 50% Scheduled Tribe (STs) population is placed at **Annexure 1**.

Ministry of Rural Development is also implementing two welfare schemes in the field of skill development for rural poor youth under the **National Rural Livelihoods Mission** (NRLM) for gainful employment and to eradicate poverty:

I. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) which is a placement linked skill development program for wage employment.

II. Skill development through Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs) enabling a trainee to take Bank credit and start his/her own Micro-enterprise. Some of such trainees may also seek regular salaried jobs.

Both the above schemes of MoRD are aimed at increasing employability of rural poor youth either for wage or self-employment leading to economic and social development of youth of rural area of the country. Under both the schemes, candidates are provided skills for sustainable employment and self-employment. The state-wise details of tribals trained and placed/ settled including Rajasthan under both DDU-GKY and RSETI is at **Annexure 2**.

The Ministry of Tribal Affairs implements the scheme of **Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Vikas Mission (PMJVM)** which inter alia comprises the component of 'Mechanism for Marketing of Minor Forest Produce (MFP) through Minimum Support Price (MSP) & Development of Value Chain for MFP' and 'Institutional Support for Development and Marketing of Tribal Products/Produce'.

The component "Van Dhan Vikas Karyakaram" under PMJVM aims to tap into traditional knowledge and skill sets of tribals by adding technology & IT to upgrade it at each stage and to convert the tribal wisdom into a viable economic activity. Since the launch of Van Dhan Yojana, TRIFED, which is the nodal agency at the national level for implementation of the scheme, has sanctioned 3225 Van Dhan Vikas Kendras associated with more than 9.63 lakhs beneficiaries in 25 States and 3 UTs of the country. It is envisaged that it would play a vital role in improving overall economy of tribal community

of our country. 921 VDVKs are operational and total sale made by VDVKs is to the tune of Rs. 2304.36 lakhs till date. The details of Year-wise and State-wise sanctioned VDVKs including Rajasthan are at **Annexure 3**.

Also, TRIFED imparts skill up-gradation training from time to time to tribal beneficiaries associated with TRIFED for supply of tribal products under the scheme component 'Institutional Support for Development and Marketing of Tribal Products/Produce'. The details of different kind of skill trainings being imparted by TRIFED are as under:

1. Comprehensive Training Programme (CTP): This Training is for 60 days with a budget of Rs. 3.70 Lakh for a batch of 20 beneficiaries per training.

2. **Design Workshop Training (DWT):** To take the CTP beneficiaries to the next level, this training is designed to impart training for those products which have potential of including into main supply chain of Tribes India. The training is for 21 days for a batch of 20 beneficiaries with a budgetary provision of Rs. 2.00 Lakh per training.

3. **Design & Technology up-gradation cum Production Workshop (DTPW):** The focus for this training is to develop design input and/ or new product development, technological adaptation and adoption of innovative technical process. This is conducted under the guidance of renowned designers for development of designs and products of international standing for both domestic & international markets. The training workshop is conducted for existing empanelled suppliers of TRIFED and is aimed for introduction of new product range in Tribes India. The training is for 60 days for a batch of 20 tribal beneficiaries with a budget of Rs. 8.50 Lakh.

Further, under Tech for Tribals Initiative, TRIFED has also initiated entrepreneurship training programs to Van Dhan beneficiaries, funds for which have been provided by the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) under their **Entrepreneurship Skill Development Programme** (ESDP) scheme. Under the ESDP scheme, MSME has sanctioned an amount of Rs.1846.25 Lakhs to TRIFED for conducting ESDP training to Van Dhan beneficiaries. TRIFED has engaged 14 Training Partners covering 26 States sanctioning an amount of Rs.1825 Lakhs to whom Rs 895 Lakhs have been released. The Training Partners have so far completed trainings of 415 batches in the 15 States covering 10375 VDVK beneficiaries.

Also, the Ministry provides funds for skill development / vocational training programmes to State Governments under the Schemes of 'Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme (SCA to TSS) and Grants under Article 275(1) of the Constitution. The details of funds provided for skill development and vocational training of tribal persons under the schemes 'Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme (SCA to TSS) and Grants under Article 275(1) of the Constitution (SCA to TSS) and Grants under Article 275(1) of the Constitution during last four years is at Annexure 4.

(e): Government is implementing Tribal Sub-Plan (TSP)/Schedule Tribe Component (STC)/Development Action Plan for STs (DAPST) for overall development of tribal people across the country. Besides Ministry of Tribal Affairs, 41 Central Ministries / Departments have been obligated for earmarking in the range of 4.3 to 17.5 percent of their total Scheme allocation every year as STC/TSP/DAPST funds for tribal development. STC/TSP/DAPST funds are spent by different Central Ministries / Departments under their schemes for various development projects relating to education, health, agriculture, irrigation, roads, housing, drinking water, electrification, employment generation, skill development, etc. for accelerated socio-economic development of Scheduled Tribes.
