(a) to (e): The disinvestment targets and actual disinvestment receipts during the period 2017-18 to 2021-22 are given as under:

2021-22	78000	13531

Disinvestment process depends on several factors such as constantly changing market conditions & geo political economic developments, investors' perceptions and interest about CPSE stocks and available opportunities for disinvestment. During the last few years, there have been serious uncertainties in economic and market environment owing to Covid pandemic, global economic turmoil and geo-political tensions adversely affecting the disinvestment process, completion of ongoing transactions and launching of new transactions.
