- (a) whether the Government, in consultation with ASI, has any plan for strengthening and restoration of monuments in Karnataka;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, district-wise;
- (c) whether the Government, in consultation with ASI, has any plan for restoration and strengthening of the following protected monuments; namely Saint Shri Allamaprabhu's (the great Guru of Shri Basavanna, Philosopher and Saint of 12th Century) birth place in Shikaripura taluk, Shri Lakshminarasimhaswamy Temple in Bhadravathi taluk and Bidanur fort in Hosanagara taluk which are located in the parliamentary constituency of Shimoga; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, monument-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF CULTURE, TOURISM AND DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION (SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

- (a) There are 506 Centrally Protected Monuments in Karnataka, including Bidanur
- to Fort in Hosanagara taluk, by the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) and they
- (d) are in a good state of preservation. District-wise details are at Annexure. Necessary conservation works are taken up by ASI from time to time as per requirement and availability of resources. Saint Shri Allamaprabhu's (the great Guru of Shri Basavanna, Philosopher and Saint of 12th Century) birth place in Shikaripura taluk and Shri Lakshminarasimhaswamy Temple in Bhadravathi taluk are not under the jurisdiction of the ASI, and there is no plan for their restoration and strengthening.
