(a) whether only 7.55 per cent of students are from Minority communities in higher education as found in All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether the Government has analysed the reasons for lack of participation of minority communities in higher education and if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the efforts made or proposed to be made by the Government to improve the participation of minority communities in higher education?

(a) to (c) As per the All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) 2019-20, 7.76% of the students enrolled in Higher Education at various levels (undergraduate, post-graduate, M.Phil &Ph.D) are from the six minority communities, namely, Muslims, Buddhists, Jains, Christians, Sikhs and Parsis. Between 2013-14 and 2019-20, the enrolment of students in higher education from Minority communities has increased by nearly 47%. The National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) also emphasizes on Equitable and Inclusive Education by focusing on Socially and Economically Disadvantaged Groups (SEDGs) which includes students from minority communities. Further, the Government is implementing various schemes for providing financial assistance to all categories of students including students from minority communities.
