- (a) to (c): Yes, Sir. The Ministry of Tourism has drafted a new National Tourism Policy. The draft policy was circulated to Central Ministries, State Governments/UT Administrations and Industry Stakeholders for seeking their comments/feedback/suggestions. The draft Policy has been updated incorporating the suggestions/feedback received. The Ministry of Tourism has initiated the process of seeking approval of the Cabinet on the draft Policy.
- (d): As per estimation in accordance with 3rd Tourism Satellite Account for subsequent years namely 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 the contribution of tourism to GDP of the country is given at annexure.
