(a) & (b): The NIC comprised of Hon'ble Prime Minister as Chairperson and Union Ministers, Leaders of Opposition in Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha, Chief Ministers of all States and UTs with Legislatures, Leaders of National Political Parties, Chairpersons of National Commissions, Media Persons, Representatives of Business, Representatives of Labour, Eminent Public Figure and Women's Representatives as members.

Meetings of the National Integration Council (NIC) are convened as per requirement from time to time. There is no regular or specified time interval for convening meeting of the NIC. The last meeting of the NIC was held on 23.09.2013.
