DATA ON FPIs POTENTIAL

255. SHRI PARVESH SAHIB SINGH VERMA:

Will the Minister of *FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES* be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any survey/data/ information on Food Processing Industry (FPI) potential of Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has any proposal to set up Mega Park for food processing in Delhi and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to boost food processing industries in Delhi?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) & (b): The data for registered manufacturing sector including food processing sector is brought out by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) through the Annual Survey of Industries (ASI). As per the latest Annual Survey of Industries 2018-19, data pertaining to Delhi and all India is mentioned in the table below:

(c) & (d): No Sir. Apart from the implementation of schemes like Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana (PMKSY), PM Formalisation of Micro food processing Enterprises Scheme (PMFME), Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLIS), the Government has taken several measures to boost food processing industries in the country including Delhi e.g. classification of food & agrobased processing units and cold chain infrastructure as agricultural activity for Priority Sector Lending (PSL), Special fund of National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) for lending to food processing industries. Under PMFME, 11 districts have been identified for One District One Product (ODOP) in Delhi. A total of 613 units has been allocated for coverage in five years and an amount of Rs. 81.83 lakhs has been released to Delhi during 2020-21 & 2021-22. 8 food testing labs have been also completed in Delhi.
