**ALL-INDIA TRADE PORTAL FOR AGRICULTURE SECTOR**

2550. SHRI BALAK NATH:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is an All-India trade portal of the Union Government for the agriculture sector in Rajasthan and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has any data showing the number of farmers benefitted under this scheme in Rajasthan; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c): National Agriculture Market (e-NAM) is envisaged as a pan-India electronic trading platform launched by Government of India on 14th April, 2016 with the objective of creating online transparent competitive price discovery system to facilitate farmers with remunerative prices for their produce.

So far, 1000 mandis of 18 States and 3 UTs have been integrated with e-NAM platform which also includes 144 mandis of Rajasthan. As on 30.06.2022, more than 1.73 crore farmers & more than 2.26 Lakhs traders have been registered on e-NAM platform. The agricultural produce trade with a value of Rs 2.04 lakh crore have so far been recorded on e-NAM platform which also include trade value of Rs 38,794 crore from Rajasthan state.

As on 30.06.2022, more than 15.0 Lakh farmers have been registered in Rajasthan State to avail various facilities and assistance under National Agriculture Market (e-NAM).
