### TRAINING TO YOUTH IN THE ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING SECTORS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes or any scheme is being implemented to impart training to youth in Animal Husbandry and Dairying Sector in the country particularly in Maharashtra and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the number of youth who have been imparted training under the said scheme in the country during the last three years and the current year along with the details thereof, district-wise including Latur district and Madha Lok Sabha Constituency in Maharashtra, Jalore, Sirohi districts in Rajasthan and Bilaspur, Mungeli and Gaurela-Pendra-Marwahi districts in Chhattisgarh; and
- (c) whether the Government proposes to provide loans to the youth at subsidized interest rate after the said training and if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

# THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

(a) & (b) Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India is implementing National Livestock Mission (NLM) scheme and under NLM, there is a sub-mission named Innovation and Extension, through which farmers of all strata including youth are trained on various Animal Husbandry activities. During the year 2021-22, 4882 farmers were trained in Chhattisgarh. No farmers were trained in Maharashtra and Rajasthan during the last three years and current year.

Further, under one of the components of Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM), educated ruralyouthsare trained and inducted as Multi Purpose AI Technicians in Rural India(MAITRIs). Under this component, assistance is made available to MAITRIs fortraining and artificial insemination equipment. MAITRIs are playing important role indelivery of artificial insemination services at farmer's doorstep. Rashtriya Gokul Mission has been implemented throughout the country covering all the districts andso far 13586 MAITRIs have been inducted during the last three years and currentyear in States and Union Territories including Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan. State-wise and District-wise details of MAITRIs established are at **Annexure-I** and **Annexure-II** respectively.

(c)The Government is imparting trainingsfor the youth under the MAITRI component of RGM scheme and "Innovation and Extension" component of NLM scheme. Under these components, trained framers are eligible to get benefits of subsidies and loans.
