SETTING UP OF INTEGRATED CHECK POSTS

†2616. SHRI RAHUL KASWAN:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has decided to set up Integrated Check Posts for cargo and passenger traffic at the entry points of the land borders of Pakistan, Nepal, Bangladesh and Myanmar;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the details of the locations identified along the borders for setting up of the above check posts; and

(d) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(SHRI NISITH PRAMANIK)**

(a) to (d): Central Government, under the provisions of the Land Ports Authority of India (LPAI) Act, 2010, develops Integrated Check Posts (ICPs) for cross-border movement of passengers and goods at designated points along the international borders.

So far 9 ICPs have been made operational and their details are at Annexure – I.

Apart from the above, Central Government has also decided to develop

ICPs at 14 different locations on Indo-Nepal, Indo-Bangladesh, Indo-Bhutan borders. The details of these 14 locations are at Annexure – II, which are at different stages of development.
