Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE

- (a) the places in the country where agricultural universities/colleges administered by the Union Government are located, State-wise;
- (b) the norms set for opening new agricultural universities in the country;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to open an agricultural university in Pindwara (TSP area) located in Sirohi to make the youth here agricultural entrepreneurs and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government has made any plan to provide employment related education to the high school and intermediate pass youths of Pindwara and make them successful agricultural entrepreneurs and if so, the details thereof?

**(b):** Agriculture including Agricultural Education being the state subject, opening of new Agricultural Universities comes under the purview of respective State Government. **(c):** There is no such proposal to open an agricultural university in Pindwara (TSP area) located in Sirohi.

**(d):** Vocational skill development programs in agriculture and allied activities for youths are implemented to promote agricultural entrepreneurship in country through State Agricultural Universities, ICAR-Deemed Universities and Central Agricultural Universities. In these programs, people from all parts of the country can participate.
