## VACANCIES IN CAPFs

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:
(a) the details of vacancies in Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) as on 31st July, 2022, force-wise;
(b) the details of vacancies in CAPFs reserved for defence personnel as on 31st July 2022;
(c) the total number of vacancies filled up in CAPFs during each of the last five years and the current year, force-wise; and
(d) whether the Government proposes to fill up fresh posts in CAPFs; and
(e) if so, whether the Government has taken any steps in this regard, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

## ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)
(a): Details of vacancies in Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) \& Assam Rifles (AR) as on $31^{\text {st }}$ July, 2022, Force-wise are as under :

(b): As per the instructions of Department of Personnel and Training issued vide notification dated 04.10.2012, 10 \% vacancies in Central Armed Police Forces \& Assam Rifles are reserved for Ex-servicemen upto the level of Assistant Commandant to be filled by direct recruitment. Further, in-principle approval has been given for reservation of $10 \%$ of vacancies for Ex-Agniveers in the recruitment to the post of Constable (General Duty)/Rifleman in the Central Armed Police Forces and Assam Rifles when the first batch of Ex-Agniveers is available for recruitment after completing engagement period of four years in Defence Forces.
(c): The total number of vacancies filled up in CAPFs \& AR during each of the last five years and the current year, force-wise are as under :

(d) \& (e): The Government has taken a decision to fill up existing vacancies in CAPFs \& AR by December, 2023. It is stated that the examination for filling up of $\mathbf{2 5 , 2 7 1}$ posts of Constable (General Duty) has
already been conducted. The Government has taken inter alia the following further steps to fill up the vacancies expeditiously in CAPFs \& AR :-
(i) Yearly recruitment for the post of Constable (General Duty) for which a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed with Staff Selection Commission (SSC).
(ii) For coordinating recruitment to General Duty posts, a Nodal Force each for recruitment in the rank of Constable (General Duty), SubInspector (GD) and Assistant Commandant (General Duty) has been nominated on long term basis.
(iii) Directions issued to all Central Armed Police Forces and Assam Rifles to undertake recruitment against vacant posts in NonGeneral Duty cadres in a time-bound manner.
(iv) Timely conducting meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) for filling up of promotional vacancies.
