**ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT FUND (AHIDF)**

2649: SHRI AJAY KUMAR MANDAL

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING  
मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री  
be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the amount allocated by the Government for dairy processing and product diversification infrastructure under Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Funds (AHIDF) since the year 2020 till now;
- (b) the details of beneficiaries to be benefited from the allocated amount, state-wise including Bihar;
- (c) the number of beneficiaries who have taken loan in the State of Bihar including Bhagalpur district under AHIDF;
- (d) the details of scheduled bank which have given loans to the beneficiaries indicating the amount thereof, district-wise;
- (e) whether the Government provides any training to the persons/ cooperative societies to make them technologically capable who are working in this sector to strengthen the dairy industry; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING  
(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

- (a) Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF) is a central sector scheme with the corpus of Rs 15000 crore under Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan stimulus package for incentivizing the (i) the dairy processing and value addition infrastructure, (ii) meat processing and value addition infrastructure (iii) Animal Feed Plant (iv) Breed improvement technology and Breed multiplication farm (v) Setting up of veterinary vaccine and drugs production facilities and (vi) Animal waste of wealth management (Agri waste management).

There is no specific allocation for dairy processing and value addition infrastructure under Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF), however projects amounting to Rs 2019.14 Crore have been sanctioned for Dairy processing and value chain related investment.

(b) The Scheme is demand driven. It is expected that altogether 35 lakh farmers will be benefitted under the Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF) in the country.

(c) There are four beneficiaries who have taken loan in the State of Bihar under AHIDF. The details are as under:

(e) & (f) Yes Sir, under the National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD) implemented by the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, provision has been made for providing training for Farmers on Good Hygienic practices or good manufacturing practices, dairy personnel / milk taster (including plant and marketing staff), quality management systems and training of dairy cooperative society staff/ bulk milk cooler/chilling centre/ Automatic Milk Chilling Unit (AMCU) and Data Processor & Milk Collection Unit (DPMCU) on operations and quality management.
