#### **EXPANSION OF FPIs IN RAJASTHAN**

#### 2655. SHRI NIHAL CHAND: SHRI PATEL HASMUKHBHAI SOMABHAI: SHRI HANUMAN BENIWAL:

Will the Minister of *FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES* be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Government has conducted any study regarding setting up and expansion of food processing industries in the country and if so, the details thereof, state-wise:
- (b) The progress made in the establishment/ expansion of food processing industries in the country during the last three years, state wise including Rajasthan;
- (c) The steps being taken by the Government for the expansion and proliferation of food processing industries in the country; and
- (d) Whether the Government proposed to formulate any scheme to develop food park in Nagaur district and if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

### THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

- (a) & (b): The data for registered food processing industries is brought out by the Ministry of Statistic and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) through the Annual Survey of Industries (ASI). The latest ASI data is available up to 2018-19 and details of State-wise food processing units including Rajasthan for latest three available years i.e. 2016-17, 2017-18 and 2018-19 is at **Annexure**.
- (c): The Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) is implementing various sub schemes of PMKSY which is a comprehensive package for creation of modern infrastructure with efficient supply chain management from farm gate to retail outlet. It not only provides boost to the growth of food processing sector in the country but also helps in providing better returns to farmers, creating employment opportunities, reducing loss of agricultural produce, increasing the processing level and enhancing export of processed foods. Expression of Interest (EoI) has been floated on 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2022 for inviting fresh proposals for setting-up food processing facilities.
- (d): The continuation of Mega Food Park (MFP) scheme during 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission cycle has not been approved by the Government.
