PMGSY WORK IN UP

2686. SHRI ASHOK KUMAR RAWAT:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the work of package no. UP33175 [the old work from GMM Road to Nevada Paras (Mallawan)] has been completed and the renewal work and the five yearly maintenance work is being carried out of the package no. UP 16R (Package-Group No.33-16R) through the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) in the year 2021-22 in the districts under the Parliamentary Constituency of Misrikh of Uttar Pradesh particularly in the Hardoi district;
- (b) if so, the details therefor;
- (c) whether the Government has received complaints from the public representatives in May 2022 to look into the matter related to the sub standard construction material being used in the construction work of the above said packages by constituting a high level technical committee at Union Ministry level and to ensure the departmental action against the engineers involved after through investigation along with request for stopping the misuse of central revenue with immediate effort;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the action taken or being taken by the Government on this matter?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) The work of package no. UP33175 [GMM Road to Nevada Paras (Mallawan)] was sanctioned under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana-III (PMGSY-III) in 2020-21 and the same has been completed on 24.04.2022. The said road is under Defect Liability Period (DLP) of 5 years.

(c) to (e) No such complaint has been received in the Ministry. However as per the information received from the State Government of Uttar Pradesh, in the meeting of District Monitoring Committee, complaint of uprooting of ballast on the said road was raised by Hon'ble Member of Parliament. State Government has further informed that the restoration work of the said road has now been completed by the concerned contractor. The road was also inspected by State Quality Monitor and has been found to be satisfactory. The concerned Chief Engineer, PMGSY of the State has also inspected the road and found it to be in order.
