**2756. SHRI BRIJENDRA SINGH:**

Will the Minister of ***FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES*** be pleased to state:

- (a) the quantum of funds allocated, released, and utilised under the One District One Product (ODOP) programme in Haryana as of July 2022;
- (b) whether one of the aims of ODOP is to reduce wastage and provide support for proper storage of agricultural products and if so, the steps taken in the State of Haryana in pursuance of these; and
- (c) the status of implementation of ODOP in Hisar, since the launch of the scheme, as of July 2022?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b): Ministry of Food Processing Industries is implementing PM Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme in the country with One District One Product (ODOP) approach to reap the benefit of scale in terms of procurement of inputs, availing common services and marketing of products. ODOP provides overall framework of the scheme for value chain development and alignment of support infrastructure. The Details of ODOPs identified for all the districts of Haryana is placed at **Annexure**. An amount of Rs 6,37,15,817/- has been released under the scheme to Haryana, out of which Rs 95,65,805/- has been utilised by the State so far.

(c): Milk based products has been identified as ODOP for the district of Hisar (Haryana). So far, 56 applications from ODOP (Milk Based Products) based individual micro food processing enterprises have been submitted in Hisar district, out of which 11 loans have been sanctioned by banks. 2 Self Help Group (SHG) members have been recommended for Seed Capital amounting to Rs. 80,000/-.
