Jobs to Villagers Residing Near Nuclear Plants

2827. SHRI VELUSAMY P.:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether at least one member from every family living in villages near the proposed Kalpakkam and Kudankulam nuclear power plant in Tamilnadu will get a job in the plant when it becomes operational;
- (b) if so, whether the Government has given the same concession to the people living in villages around Kalpakkam Nuclear establishment and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the total number of pieces of land acquired at Kalpakkam and the jobs given to the landowners at Kalpakkam nuclear establishment; and
- (d) the reasons for not giving jobs to Kalpakkam villagers who offered their land while it is being offered at Jaitapur?
