- (a) the number of sports hostels and sports schools run by the Union and State Governments and Sports Authority of India in each State;**
- (b) the number of sports, both games and field events, disciplines sponsored by the above sports hostels and sports schools;**
- (c) the number of players and athletes enrolled to train and simultaneously continue their academic courses in the above hostels and schools; and**
- (d) the number of day-scholars enrolled for the training in each discipline and in each State?**

**(a) to (d): Sports being a State Subject, the responsibility to promote sports, including creating of sports infrastructure, primarily rests with the respective State/UT Governments. However, Central Government supplements their efforts through its various schemes, including the Khelo India Scheme and the sports promotional schemes run by Sports Authority of India (SAI).**
