Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the district-wise number of operational godowns in Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, Jammu and Kashmir, Jharkhand, Maharashtra for storing foodgrains and the number of farmers getting benefits from the said godowns especially in Amravati district;
- (b) the capacity of these godowns in the said States and whether the capacity is sufficient for storage of foodgrains for the States, separately;
- (c) if not, whether the Government plans to set up more godowns in the said States, especially in Amravati district and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the funds allocated to Maharashtra under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana; and
- (e) the criteria adopted for the said fund allocation?

(a) & (b): Food Corporation of India (FCI) calculates storage gap in a state on the basis of foodgrains requirement under National Food Security Act (NFSA) & Other Welfare Schemes (OWS). Taking available and proposed capacity in Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, Jammu and Kashmir, Jharkhand and Maharashtra, the storage capacity is sufficient as per norms.



Details of district-wise number of operational godowns in Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, Jammu and Kashmir, Jharkhand and Maharashtra for storing foodgrains and the number of farmers getting benefits from the said godowns are at Annexure-I.

As on 01.07.2022, Covered Storage capacity available with FCI (owned and hired) for storage of foodgrain in the State of Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, Jammu and Kashmir, Jharkhand and Maharashtra is at Annexure-II.

Central Warehousing Corporation (CWC) is not operating any Warehouse in the UT of Jammu and Kashmir/Ladakh as on 1st July, 2022. The district-wise No. of warehouses where Foodgrains are stored and Capacity utilized by Farmers in the State of Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, Jharkhand and Maharashtra are at Annexure-III.

Further, in CWC, the storage capacity where Foodgrains are stored in the State of Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, Jharkhand and Maharashtra is at Annexure-IV.

(c): To plug the storage gap and to accommodate storage requirement due to increasing procurement, FCI continuously assesses and monitors the storage capacity and based on the storage gap assessment, storage capacities are created/hired through the following schemes: -

1. Private Entrepreneurs Guarantee (PEG) Scheme
2. Central Sector Scheme (CSS)
3. Construction of Silos under PPP mode
4. Hiring of godown from Central Warehousing Corporation (CWC)/ State Warehousing Corporation (SWCs)/State Agencies
5. Hiring of godown through Private Warehousing Scheme (PWS)

A Hub Silo of 1 LMT storage capacity has been proposed in Amravati district under Hub & Spoke Silos Model.

Further, w.r.t. CWC, there is no future construction plan in the Distt. Of Amravati.

The future construction plan of CWC, on above states is at Annexure-V.

(d) & (e): As per Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI), Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana (PMKSY) is a Central Sector Scheme, State-wise funds have not been allocated under PMKSY Scheme, there is no such criteria. All the projects approved under PMKSY are application based which MoFPI approves after scrutiny of application of the applicants as per scheme guidelines. However, in the state of Maharashtra, 132 Projects have been approved with total project cost of Rs. 3006.13 crore, total approved grant of Rs. 904.36 crore and total released grant-in-aid of Rs. 648.00 crore.
