PROGRESS UNDER ATAL INNOVATION MISSION

2896. SHRIMATI SANGEETA KUMARI SINGH DEO:

Will the Minister of **PLANNING** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has approved the continuation of Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), till March 2023 and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has planned to establish 10000 Atal Tinkering Labs (ATLs) , 101 Atal Incubation Centers (AICs) , 50 Atal Community Innovation Centers (ACICs) and supporting 200 startups via the Atal New India Challenges and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of progress made under the AIM so far, year and State-wise; and
- (d) the other steps being taken by the Government for creating an innovation culture and entrepreneurial ecosystem in the country?

ANSWER

- (a) Yes, the cabinet has approved the extension of Atal Innovation Mission till March 2023. The approval has been accorded in the cabinet meeting held on 7th April 2022 and the approval to AIM has been accorded to meet the following targets:
 - a. Establishing 10,000 Atal Tinkering Labs
 - b. Establishing 101 Atal Incubation Centers
 - c. Establishing 50 Atal Community Innovation Centers
 - d. Support 200 startups via Atal New India Challenges
- (b) Yes, the AIM intends to meet the said targets. Currently, AIM has completed the target of establishing 10000 Atal Tinkering Labs in the entire country and is in progress to meet the other targets. AIM has currently established 68 Atal incubation Centers, 14 Atal Community Innovation Centers and has supported 51 startups with Grant-in-Aid to implement their ideas.

(c) The detailed table of all the beneficiaries supported by the Atal Innovation Mission state-wise and year-wise is placed as Annexure I.

(d) Government of India has been continuously working on developing the startup and innovation ecosystem of the country. The support provided by the government via various departments extends from establishment of incubators to providing seed funding to the innovators for development of prototypes via various grant-in-aid schemes.
