PROGRESS MADE UNDER BHARATNET

2960. SHRI M.V.V. SATYANARAYANA:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the progress made under BharatNet, which aims at providing connectivity to 2.5 lakh Gram Panchayats through optical fibre including the impact of the same, State-UT-wise;

(b) whether the Government is looking to further extend the scope of the same; and

(c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

(a) The State/UT wise details of progress made under BharatNet is given in **Annexure-I**. The infrastructure created under BharatNet project is a national asset, accessible on a non-discriminatory basis to the Service Providers, and the same can be utilized to provide benefits of telecom services, such as e-Health, e-Education, e-Agriculture services etc. to the citizens.

(b) & (c) The scope of BharatNet has been extended to connect all inhabited villages beyond GPs across the country.
