## Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION

be pleased to state:-

(a) whether the country's aviation regulator proposes to allow drone pilot training at the flight training organizations;

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the number of drone pilot training

centres in the country as on date, State/UT-wise;

(c) the steps being taken to set up more drone pilot training schools in future by granting permissions to private firms, institutions under the State and the Union Government;

(d) the details of the policy worked out/implemented in this regard;

(e) whether the aviation academies have been granted permission to carry out remote pilot training programmes using Remotely Piloted Aircraft Systems (RPAS) or drones and if so, the details thereof; and

(f) the basis on which permission has been granted along with the details of the training programmes?

#### **ANSWER**

<sup>(</sup>a) to (f) As per Drone Rules, 2021, any person, including Flying Training Organisations (FTO), who intends to obtain the authorisation to establish a

Remote Pilot Training Organisation (RPTO) shall submit an application to the Director General of the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) on the online DigitalSky Platform. The Director General may, within sixty days of the date of receipt of application issue the authorisation to establish a RPTO if the applicant meets the specified requirements.

The Drone Rules, 2021, notified in August 2021, provide the regulatory framework in respect of drone ownership, operations and training. These rules cover various aspects like type certification, registration and operation of drones, airspace restrictions, research, development and testing of drones, training and licensing, offences and penalties etc.

The Drone (Amendment) Rules, 2022, notified in February 2022, abolished the requirement of a drone pilot licence. Under these rules, a Remote Pilot Certificate (RPC) issued by a DGCA-authorised RPTO is adequate for a remote pilot to operate drones.

In order to provide drone training, aviation academies are required to submit an application to DGCA on the Digital Sky Platform, along with the specified fees. Approval for establishing a RPTO is granted as per Rule 39 of the Drone Rules, 2021 subject to meeting the requirements as specified in the Drone Rules, 2021, Drone (Amendment) Rules, 2022 and Drone Training Circulars.

DGCA has specified a five-day course for grant of Remote Pilot Certificate by a DGCA-authorised RPTO. The course comprises ground classes and practical training. The detailed syllabus is available on DGCA's online Digital Sky Platform.

As of 20th July 2022, 27 RPTOs have been granted authorisation by DGCA. The State/UT-wise list of RPTOs is attached in Annexure.
