(b) the details of budgetary outlay and phases of implementation of Krishi

ÙDAN 2.0, scheme State-wise;

(c) the list of airports selected as a part of Krishi UDAN 2.0, State-wise; and (d) whether the Ministry proposes to collaborate with other Ministries such as the Ministry of Railways and the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways to facilitate last mile connectivity and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) Krishi Udan Scheme 2.0 was announced on 27 October 2021 enhancing the existing provisions, mainly focusing on transporting perishable food products from the hilly areas, North-Eastern States and tribal areas. The aims and objectives of the Krishi Udan Scheme of the Ministry of Civil Aviation are to improve value realisation especially in North-East and tribal regions through improved supply chain competitiveness along with more air connectivity between origin-destination airports at affordable rates on international and national routes. The Scheme envisages resources-pooling through convergences between different schemes administered by various Central Ministries/ Departments and those of State Governments through incentives and concessions for enhancing the air transportation of agri-produce by:
- (i) providing more air connectivity (national and international) between origin-destination airports aimed at bringing in improved logistics efficiency. (ii) improving infrastructure and performance in processing of air cargo by all stakeholders, including Agri-produce, horticulture, fisheries, livestock products at airports and off-airport facilities, by regulatory participating governmental agencies (PGAs).

(iii) imparting special focus to air freight of organic and natural produce of

NER, Tribal and Hilly Districts.

(iv) achieving better and timely mapping of Agri-produce production/ supply centres with domestic demand clusters and international markets in sync with the marketing strategies.

(v) promoting end-to-end adoption of plant and animal quarantine and other

regulatory requirements (at airport) in the export supply chains.

(vi) enabling paperless and contactless interface with all stakeholders through digitisation and digitalisation via integration with existing e-platforms and their creation as required.

(b) to (d) There is no separate budgetary allocation for the Krishi Udan Scheme. This Scheme envisages the convergence among eight Ministries / Departments namely Ministry of Civil Aviation, Department of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare, Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Food Processing Industries, Department of Commerce, Ministry of Tribal Affairs and Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (DoNER), to leverage their existing schemes for strengthening the logistics for transportation of Agri-produce. Under the Scheme, for facilitating and incentivising movement of Agri-produce by air transportation, Airports Authority of India (AAI) provides full waiver of Landing, Parking, Terminal Navigational Landing Charges (TNLC), and Route Navigation Facility Charges (RNFC) for Indian freighters and Passenger to Cargo (P2C) at selected Airports of AAI. The list of 58 airports selected as a part of Krishi Udan 2.0 is at Annexure.
