- (a) the details of allotment of slots, airport, airline, day and time-wise;
- (b) the number of slots which are unutilised out of the allocated slots airport, airline, day and time-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to formulate direction to re-allocate the unutilised slots on demand; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a): Slot Allocation Committee's meetings are held by airport operators twice a year for allocating the slots to airlines for the Summer and Winter Schedule as per the Guidelines for Slot Allocation issued by the Ministry of Civil Aviation. These schedules are available in the public domain on the website of Directorate General of Civil Aviation (<https://www.dgca.gov.in/digigov-portal/?page=4201/4200/servicename>).

(b) to (d): Since, slot allocation is a regular process held twice a year based on the Committee's meetings, unutilized slots (if any) of any Schedule are reviewed/ addressed in the subsequent meetings and allocated to interested airlines. However, no such data of unutilised slots is maintained.
