SCHEMES UNDER MSME SECTOR

3152. SHRI NABA KUMAR SARANIA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

(a) the details of various schemes being run by the Ministry, State and districtwise;

(b) whether special importance has been given to North-Eastern States including Assam by MSME sector and if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the investment has increased or decreased in the MSME sector during the last five years and if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and

(d) the manner in which the North Eastern States including Assam have been benefitted by the MSME sector?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH VERMA)

(a): For the growth and development of MSMEs in the country including North Eastern States, the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) implements various schemes which inter alia include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Micro and Small Enterprises-Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI), Credit Guarantee Scheme for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE), A Scheme for Promoting Innovation, Rural Industry & Entrepreneurship (ASPIRE).

(b): The scheme 'Promotion of MSMEs in North Eastern Region and Sikkim' initiated in the year 2016 is implemented for the growth and development of MSME sector exclusively in the North Eastern States including Assam. The scheme provides financial support for augmenting infrastructure for enhancing the productivity and competitiveness of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) of North Eastern Region (NER) including Assam. Sub-components of the scheme are as follows.

i. Setting up of new and modernization of existing Mini Technology Centres.

ii. Development of new and existing Industrial Estates.

iii. Development of Tourism Sector.

(c): During the last five years, Budget Estimate (BE) for the Ministry of MSME has increased, as given below.

(d): In the North Eastern States including Assam, the Scheme "Promotion of MSMEs in NER and Sikkim" envisages to provide financial support for enhancing the productivity and competitiveness as well as capacity building of MSMEs. MSMEs can avail the facilities to improve the productivity and quality of their products stalled at Tool Room and Training Centres (TRTCs)/ Technology Centres. Financial assistance is provided for development of new and existing Industrial Estates, Flatted Factory Complexes for development of new and existing Industrial Estates in which facilities distribution the infrastructure include power system, water. telecommunication, drainage & pollution control facilities, roads, banks, storage and marketing outlets etc. For the development of tourism sector in NER and Sikkim, projects for creation of common services such as kitchen, bakery, laundry & dry cleaning, refrigeration and cold storage, IT infra, potable water, display centre for local products, centre for cultural activities etc. in a cluster of home stays are undertaken.

Various other schemes of the Ministry of MSME also support the growth and development of MSMEs in NER.
