**(a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The State Forest Department has not allowed the widening of existing road from km 97 to km 104 (Bagaha Madanpur) and bituminous work from km 104 to km 110 (Madanpur-Paniyahwa-UP Border).**

**(c) and (d) Yes, Sir. Detailed Project report for alternate route from km. 95.200 near S.S.B. Camp (Ausani Village) to U.P Border on NH-727 - in the boundary zone of Valmiki wildlife Sanctuary & Tiger Reserve along Gandak river bank in Bihar State has been taken up.**
