INCOME CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

3187. SHRIMATI SAJDA AHMED:

Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to revise the income criteria for the parents to avail the scholarship schemes for minority communities so that the benefits are accessible to more students and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government proposes an interest subsidy on educational loans for the student pursuing higher education in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the funds under 'Padho Pardesh' scheme distributed to the beneficiaries, State-wise; and
- (d) the details of the placement of the students of the minority communities who completed technical education assisted by educational loan?

- (a):The process of Scheme revision is a continuous process and all aspects, including revision of the income criteria under the Scholarship Schemes, are looked into by the Ministry during such process.
