INCREASE IN SEATS OF MBBS AND PG

- (a) whether the Government proposes to increase the seats of MBBS and PG courses in Government medical college Udaipur, Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) to (c): The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) namely, 'Upgradation of existing State Government/Central Government medical colleges to increase MBBS seats and starting new PG discipline & increase of PG seats in the country'. Rabindra Nath Tagore (RNT) Medical College, Udaipur has been approved under this Scheme to increase 100 MBBS seats from 150 seats to 250 seats at a cost of Rs.120 crore and 206 new PG seats in 2 phases at a cost of Rs.193.625 crore.
