Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is true that out of 35,600 Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) in Telangana, nearly 12,700 are functioning from rented premises;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, district-wise;
- (c) the efforts being made to provide permanent premises for these 12,700 AWCs in Telangana;
- (d) the details of funds allocated to AWCs in Telangana during each of the last five years, district-wise; and
- (e) the physical targets set and achieved in Telangana during the said period, district-wise?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b) As informed by the State Government of Telangana, as on date, 12122 Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) are functioning in rented premises. District-wise details of AWCs running in rented premises is annexed.

(c) to (e) As informed by the State Government of Telangana, efforts are being made for construction of AWC buildings under MGNREGS, Rural Infrastructure Development Funds (RIDF) and Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAGY). Further, Government has issued directions to State Governments/UT Administrations to co-locate those AWCs which are running in rented premises without sufficient infrastructure (such as toilet and drinking water facilities) to the nearby primary schools. The district-wise information regarding funds released to State Governments/UT Administration is not maintained centrally. However, details of funds released to the State of Telangana during the last five years is as under:
