"CULTIVATION AND HARVEST METHODS OF HERBS"

3313. SHRI K. NAVASKANI:

Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has taken any steps to educate the farmers about herbs, their cultivation, pre-post harvest methods and their storage;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF AYUSH (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a) & (b): Yes Sir, National Medicinal Plants Board (NMPB), Ministry of Ayush has provided financial support in project mode to various institutes/organizations to organise awareness programme, exposure visits and capacity building programmes (seminars / conferences / workshops etc.) for array of stakeholders through Information Education and Communication (IEC) activities under Central Sector Scheme (CSS) for conservation, development and sustainable management of medicinal plants. NMPB has released an amount of Rs. 3079.116 lakhs and supported 124 no. of projects for various IEC activities to educate array of stakeholders including farmers about different aspects of medicinal plants like conservation, cultivation, post harvest management, marketing and their quality from the financial year 2017-18 to 2021-22. The detail is given at **Annexure I &II**.

Under the same scheme, project based support is also provided to Regional Cum Facilitation Centres (RCFCs) of NMPB for conducting and facilitating various medicinal plants activities including organizing trainings / workshops to educate farmers about the Cultivation and Post Harvest Management (PHM) of medicinal plants / herbs. The details of training / workshop conducted and farmers trained through RCFCs from 2017-18 to 2021-22 is at **Annexure III.**

Beside this, Ministry of Ayush had supported the training programmes, seminars/ workshops / Buyer-seller meet / exposure visits on cultivation practices to aware the farmers under flexi component of 'Medicinal Plants' component under National Ayush Mission scheme. Till date, Ministry of Ayush has supported 235 numbers of seminars/ workshops / buyer-seller meet / exposure visits. Details are provided at **Annexure-IV.**
