FUNDS FOR HEALTH INFRASTRUCTURE

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the funds allocated, released and utilized for the development of health infrastructure in the country during the last three years, State/UT-wise; and
- (b) the details of the funds allocated during the year 2021-22 for the development of health infrastructure in the rural areas of the country, State/UT-wise?

- (a) and (b): The primary responsibility of strengthening public healthcare system lies with the respective State Governments. However, under National Health Mission (NHM), technical and financial support is provided to the States/UTs to strengthen the public healthcare system.

States/UTs have been provided support for strengthening public healthcare system and health infrastructure through the following centrally sponsored schemes of Department of Health & Family:

- (i) **National Health Mission (NHM):** It is one of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme under which the Government of India provides financial and technical support to States/UTs to strengthen their health care systems. It comprises of two sub-missions viz. National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) and National Urban Health Mission (NUHM).

The details of approvals and utilization for the development of healthcare infrastructure in the country under NHM during the last three years, State/UT-wise is at Annexure-I.

- (ii) **ECRP-II:** The Cabinet also approved the scheme, “India Covid-19 Emergency Response and Health Systems Preparedness Package-II” (ECRP-II) on 08th July 2021 for an amount of Rs.23,123 crore for the F.Y. 2021-22. The scheme aims to accelerate health system preparedness for immediate responsiveness for early prevention, detection and management of COVID-19, with the focus on health infrastructure development including for Pediatric Care and with measurable outcomes. Details of State/UT wise funds released and utilized towards ECRP-II through Agency - National Health Mission (NHM) is given at Annexure-II.
- (iii) **PM-ABHIM:** PM-Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission (PM-ABHIM) was launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India for an amount of Rs.64,180 crore. The measures under the PM-ABHIM focus on developing capacities of health systems and institutions across the continuum of care at all levels, primary, secondary and tertiary, to prepare health systems in responding effectively to the current and future pandemics /disasters. Details of State/UT wise funds released under PM-ABHIM during F.Y. 2021-22 is at Annexure-III.
- (iv) **15th Finance Commission (FC-XV):** Government of India is supporting rural and urban local bodies through the 15th Finance Commission for addressing the gaps in Primary Healthcare facilities. Funds to the tune of Rs. 70,051 Cr have been allocated for the period from 2021-22 to 2025-26.

Further, details of approval for the development of healthcare infrastructure in rural areas of the country under National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) during FY 2021-22, State/UT-wise is at Annexure-IV.
