Will the Minister of CHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

whether the Government has proposed any scheme to ensure easy availability (a) of manures and fertilizers at cheaper prices to the poor farmers of the country;

if so, the details thereof; (b)

whether the Government has any plans to ensure the availability of fertilizer for (c) distribution across the country; and

if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including the States of West Bengal and (d) Bihar?

ANSWER

Government has been implementing Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (a) & (b) (PKVY) and Mission Organic Value Chain Development (MOVCDNER) schemes to promote organic farming since 2015-16.

PKVY is implemented in all the States and Union Territories across the country to promote organic farming in cluster mode. Under the scheme farmers are provided financial assistance of Rs 50000/ha for 3 years in which, Rs 31000/ ha / 3 years is provided directly to farmers through DBT for organic inputs such as seeds, bio fertilizers, bio-pesticides, organic manure, compost/vermi-compost, botanical extracts etc. whereas under MOVCDNER scheme, assistance is provided @ Rs. 32500/ha/3yaers to farmers for procurement/on farm production of organic inputs including organic fertilizers.

Government has been implementing Nutrient Based Subsidy Policy w.e.f. 1.4.2010 for Phosphatic and Potassic (P&K) Fertilizers. Under the policy, a fixed amount of subsidy, decided on annual/semi-annual basis, is provided on subsidized P&K fertilizers depending on their nutrient content. Under this policy, MRP is fixed by fertilizer companies as per market dynamics at reasonable level which is monitored by the Government. Accordingly, any farmer including poor and marginal farmers who are buying these fertilizers is getting benefits of subsidy. The mandate of the Department of Fertilizers is to ensure comfortable availability and supply of subsidized fertilizers to all the states/UTs. Department of Fertilizers is allocating sufficient/ adequate quantities of fertilizers to all the States/UTs on timely basis. However, distribution of fertilizers to the farmers within the state is the mandate of respective State Governments.

(c) & (d): Department of Fertilizers is ensuring comfortable availability of fertilizers across the country. The details of requirement, availability and sales of all fertilizers during ongoing Khairf 2022 (upto 31st July, 2022) is at **Annexure-I & II.**
