# MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a)&(b) Development of following National Waterways (NWs) of Kerala has been undertaken by Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) -

- 1. NW-3- West Coast Canal (Kottapuram Kollam), Champakara and Udyogmandal Canals (205 km);
- 2. NW-8- Alappuzha- Changanassery Canal (29 km) and
- 3. NW-9- Alappuzha Kottayam Athirampuzha Canal (40 km)

(c)&(d) There is no agreement between Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) and Kerala Waterways Infrastructure Limited (KWIL) to create a waterway corridor to carry passengers and cargo.
