Will the **MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to State:

- a) the details of the decline in reported Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR) across country, State/UT-wise;
- b) the name of the States/Union Territories who have adopted Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) regarding MMR; and
- c) if so, the details of the goals achieved so far, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (c) The Government of India adopted the SDG goal of reducing MMR to less than 70 per 100,000 live births by 2030.

As per the report of Sample Registration System (SRS) released by Registrar General of India (RGI), Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR) of India has reduced by 10 points from 113, per 100,000 live births in SRS 2016-18 to 103 in SRS 2017-19. **The State/UT wise MMR along with the States which have achieved the SDG target is placed at Annexure.**
