Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is contemplating to set up Skill India International Centre in the country including Assam and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of the estimated funds and projected target pertaining to the said programme;
- (c) whether the Government has identified locations for the said centres within the country including Assam and Rajasthan and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the time by which these centres are likely to be set up?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

(a) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) is contemplating setting up Skill India International (SII) Centres.

Skill India International Centres are aimed at providing high-quality training to Indian youth by providing skills as per the requirement of the international employers in countries including but not limited to United Arab Emirates (UAE), other Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) regions, Canada, Australia, Japan etc.

- (b) No separate funds have been allocated for the said programme.
- (c) and (d) The due diligence has been done by NSDC and supply clusters have been identified. The identification and empanelment process of SII Centres across the country including in the State of Assam and Rajasthan is an ongoing process.
