†3552. SHRI RAJAN VICHARE:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the Government has started a survey of domestic workers in order to make policies to protect the interests of domestic workers, in which the data of 5.5 lakh families across the country will be included;
- (b)if so, the details regarding Maharashtra thereof; and
- (c)if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (c): Yes, Sir. Labour Bureau has launched 'All India Survey on Domestic Workers' (DW) with the objective to estimate the State wise number of Domestic Workers and their Socio-economic conditions. Approximately 1.5 lakh households across 12766 villages/urban blocks are proposed to be covered in all States/UTs including the State of Maharashtra.

In State of Maharashtra, about 4500 households from 373 villages/urban blocks are proposed to be covered.
